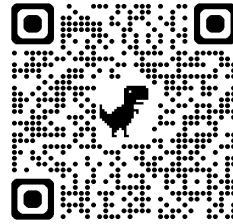

## **“What’s the Difference ....”**

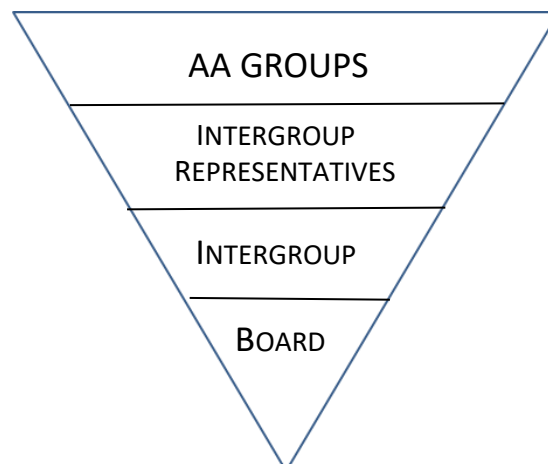
Someone recently asked “What’s the difference between the Valley Intergroup Service Center, the Intergroup and The Board.” Well, they’re really all parts of one legal entity, Valley Intergroup Service Council (Center), Inc.

VISC is organized like the General Service structure of AA, an upside-down triangle with the Groups at the top.

The **Valley Service Center** is the central business office, kind of like the General Service Office (GSO). It is to Groups, what Groups are to Members.

Our **Intergroup** is made up of Group Representatives (IGRs), who collectively discuss and make decisions about how we can better carry our message. Intergroup Reps are to Intergroup what Area Delegates are to the General Service Conference.

The **VISC Board** is made up of a group of trusted people who deal with strategic and organizational issues when they come up. Here’s the thing about our Board. Like the General Service Board of Trustees of A.A., our Board’s recommendations are only advisory, and are referred for final decision by the Group Reps (Intergroup).

There's a vital need for AA members from the outside to sponsor AA members in prisons. In order to understand this need, all you need to ask yourself is:

### **Could I have gotten sober without the help of a sponsor?**

If your answer is 'maybe not', then you understand the vital need.

Inside members frequently tell our volunteers they're not comfortable sharing their deepest secrets with other alcoholics in prison due to the chance that the information may not remain confidential. The consequences of the wrong information being revealed on the inside can be catastrophic. This is why H&I pioneered our groundbreaking Inside Visiting Sponsorship Service (IVSS).

### **ANONYMOUSLY SPONSOR AN AA MEMBER IN PRISON FROM THE SECURITY & CONVENIENCE OF YOUR HOME**

(Due to prison regulations, meeting volunteers are ineligible to participate at the facility where they volunteer)

The requirements for IVSS volunteers are:

- 1) Minimum five years' sobriety
  - 2) Solid sponsorship experience
  - 3) Knowledge & practice of AA's Steps & Traditions
  - 4) Willingness to anonymously text, receive phone calls and exchange letters.
- ~ We match same gender sponsors, but ANYONE can help us with recruiting efforts. ~
