Memphis, Tennessee

Over 50,000 AA Groups in the US and Canada are supported by nearly 500 Intergroups. These Intergroups support Groups in the same way Groups support individuals.

Between September 17th and 21st this year, 100 Central Office managers participated in the annual symposium of the Intergroups/Central Offices of Alcoholics Anonymous (ICOA) in Memphis, Tennessee.

Four days of workshops and presentations covered:

Topics of Finance and Budget, Group and Individual Contributions, Taxes and Business Licensing, Providing Literature and Grapevine items, Group Insurance, maintaining Non-Profit status, The Internet and Websites, Hotline and Answering Services, and much more.

The Treasurer of the General Service Board and the Publisher of the Grapevine made presentations to the group and General Service Office and Grapevine staff members were available throughout the symposium to answer questions and provide input.

Intergroups are the front line, helping people get to their first meeting and supporting Groups' efforts to carry the life-saving message of Alcoholics Anonymous.

This symposium was a chance for these Special Workers, who may feel confused or overwhelmed, to share, talk to and listen to others who face similar challenges.

The purpose of Bridging the gap is to bridge the gap between AA meetings in correctional facilities, hospitals, and treatment facilities, and the first AA meeting in the home community.

Volunteer members of AA meet the newly released alcoholic and accompany him or her to an AA meeting. Women meet women, and men meet men. Like all 12 Steps work, this is never to be paid for.

Incarcerated members of AA, who are nearing their release date send a request for contact to Bridging the Gap. Volunteers then respond to these requests helping the newly released individual find meetings in the AA community.
