2025 GENERAL SERVICE CONFERENCE - FINAL REPORT - WORKING TOGETHER, INCREASING TRUST -

Here are some of the highlights of the 2025 Conference Report

In 2024, int the US and Canada, there were 50,050 Groups and over 1.3 million members (est.).

General Service Office:

Operating revenue = \$19,718,318

Operating expenses = \$18,648,246

Cost of services/group = \$172.79

Contributions:

Seventh Tradition Self-Support was \$11.249 million, (60% of operating expense.)

\$4,055,657 (36%) from Individuals (32,640 contributions)

\$7,192,917 (64%) from Groups (44,391 contributions)

Slightly less than one third of active groups contributed

The average annual group contribution was \$403.19

The average individual contribution was \$124.25.

60% of group contributions and 74% of individual contributions were \$100 or less.

The core of Self-Support are smaller contributions and not the few large contributions.

Only 7 individual contributions were the maximum amount of \$7,500 There were 9 bequests of \$10,000

There's a vital need for AA members from the outside to sponsor AA members in prisons.

In order to understand this need, all you need to ask yourself is:


