### **2026 General Service Conference Report “HUMILITY in ACTION”**

On June 22nd, our CNCA06 Area Delegate, Chitra S. presented her report to the folks assembled at the District 70 meeting.

Here are some notes from her talk that night:

- 215,000 Plain Language Biig Books have been sold
- 35,000 people attended the AA International Convention in Vancouver, Canada
- 18,000 Groups listed with the General Service Office
- 30,000 individuals contributed
- Everything AA app was acquired by AA.
- The 5th Edition of Alcoholics Anonymous:
  - ◊ Approved with 12 stories from previous editions
  - ◊ \$2.1 Million in sales expected
  - ◊ Expect it on the shelves at the Valley Service Center late this year, or early 2027
- No Group is excluded—our Unity depends on this.
- We create a Safe environment for people who disagree.
- Who is not in the room?

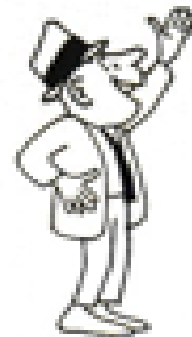
