We are looking for a responsible person to take on the position of

Assistant Treasurer.

Requirements: Five years of continuous sobriety.

A basic knowledge of Excel; minor exposure to financial activities.

Commitment: Start as Assistant Treasurer leading to two years as Treasurer. The term of the Assistant Treasurer will be based on the training progress. The position requires 4 to 5 hours per month once fully trained.

Duties: This position will create monthly reports to the VISC Board and VISC Intergroup for approval. Works closely with the Office Manager on an as needed basis. Signs for approved expenditures, tax forms and VISC financial activities. Interfaces with employed bookkeeper to provide month reporting. Manages financial requirements for the annual charity events. Attends the monthly VISC and Board meetings. Manages bank activities such as check writing as required.

Support: The current Treasurer will train this assistant with hands-on guidance. Documentation will be provided for training.

After six months, if the assistant is comfortable performing the duties above, the assistant will become the Treasurer, and a new assistant will be elected.
